ESPRESSO MARTINI £8.50

First made in the early 1980's by legendary cocktail bartender Dick Bradsell, this cocktail was designed to "wake you up!" Made with fresh coffee, vanilla vodka, Kahlua and Frangelico, this well rounded star is sure to excite your taste buds. (Contains nuts)

PORNSTAR MARTINI

£9 Created in 1999 at the Lab Bar in London, this cocktail has become an instant

classic. Made with vanilla vodka, Passoa, passion fruit purée, pineapple and vanilla, it's sweet and fruity. Served with a shot of Prosecco.

COSMOPOLITAN £9.50

Bartender Neal Murray created this classy lady in 1975 at the Cork and Clever, Minneapolis. Legend has it he started with a kamikaze and cut across with cranberry, when a customer tasted it and declared "How Cosmopolitan!" This Drink

Made with Absolut Citron, Triple Sec, fresh cranberry and fresh lemon.

CLASSIC DAIQUIRI £8.50

The history of this cocktail is somewhat lost to time. First appearing in Cuba following the American-Spanish war of 1898, the cocktail is named after where it

first appeared. Made with El Dorado 3 Year White Rum fresh lime and Gomme syrup.

VODKA MARTINI £8 DRY £8.50 DIRTY

Made to taste, either dirty or dry, this cocktail was the classic drink of choice during the American Prohibition as a more "manly" alternative to gin! Legend has it, Al Capone himself created this

Made with vodka and Martini Dry *(Olive Juice) *Dirty Martini only

MOJITO £8.50

Hailing from Havana Cuba, this cocktails origin is heavily disputed and largely lost to time. What we do know for sure is that Ernest Hemmingway was particularly fond of this drink, bringing it with him to Europe after leaving America during the Prohibition.

Made with El Dorado 3 Year white rum, Gomme syrup and soda water.

Originating from New York in 1874, the story goes that four men were in a bar discussing someone called 'Tom Collins'. This just so happened to coincide with the completion of the bartenders new

SEX ON THE BEACH

Born in Florida in Gothenburg 1980's, this cocktail is believed to have been born in response to a promotion on Schnapps. response to a promotion on schnapps. You will have to forgive the name. Supposedly named this way as "Sex" and "The Beach" were the only two reasons people went to Florida! Made with vodka, Archers, fresh orange,

OLD FASHIONED

The first recipe for this cocktail was recorded in 1862 under the name 'Whiskey Cocktail.' The Old Fashioned is generally accepted to be the world's first cocktail. Made with Makers Mark, and a dash of

LONG ISLAND ICE TEA £9

Yet another cocktail to be born during the Prohibition era, this drink was designed to hide in plain sight, looking like a normal beverage, but be deceptively alcoholic. Not for the faint hearted!

Made with Gin, Espolon Tequila, vodka, Triple sec, El Dorado 3 Year white rum, fresh lime, Gomme and Madagascan

ZOMBIE £9.95

A Classic Tiki cocktail, created in 1934 by Donn Beach at his Hollywood 'Don the Beachcomber' restaurant. Originally created to help a hungover customer get through an important business meeting, the customer returned several days later complaining that he drink had turned him into a "Zombie" for the remainder of the trip! Made with El Dorado 3 Year white rum, Old J Tiki Fire, Kraken, fresh lime, pineapple juice and a double splash of Grenadine
